Licenses: Participants must purchase a \$3.00 Nordiq Canada event licence (*not applicable to WJ SDP Program participants). The event licence fee will be automatically added to all race registrations on Zone 4 and the revenues sent directly to Nordiq Canada. Other race licenses are not required for this event.

Start List/Draw: Single Mass Start for all categories, self seeded.

Bib Pick-up: Race Day, 11am -12.30 pm, at the day lodge.

Awards: Award presentations will take place immediately following the race.

Food: Hot meal is included with participant race registration. *Extra meal tickets can be purchased through Zone 4 when registering: \$20 pp.*

Waxing: Indoor wax space is available in the basement of the day lodge. Space is limited. Bring your own equipment.

Cross Country BC's 2025-26 Wax Protocol

Cross Country BC (CCBC) respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for identified events in BC. This also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents travelling to BC from out of province or out of country. Fluoro wax is restricted for all Nordiq Canada-sanctioned events and divisionally sanctioned events. Please see the complete protocol here: <https://www.crosscountrybc.ca/ccbc-wax-protocol-2025-26>

Trail Pass: Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Race registrants do not require a trail pass. Trails will be closed to the public on race day until 3 pm.

Refunds/Cancellations: There are no refunds for registrants who do not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Race will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

Per Nordiq Canada regulation 315.9:

"With air temperatures below -20 C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 10 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition ... For U14 age groups and younger, with air temperatures below -15 C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. In that situation U14 skiers will not be authorized to race up in the U16 categories."

Race Routes: Maps will be posted on the event webpage and at the WJNSC bulletin board at the trailhead kiosk.

Awards: Times will be recorded and posted on the website following the event. All participants will get a prize at the finish line. Photo ops will be available during final presentations, on podium by the day lodge.

Feed Stations: Gatorade will be available along the lap lane in the stadium for the 10k skiers. Fruit and water will be available at the finish for all racers.

Bunnies: Bunnies registering in the Bunny Parade must be in Zone 4. There is no fee charged to Bunnies.

Bunnies must be accompanied by an adult on the race route. Adults do not require event registration.

Bunnies will receive the hot meal as race participants. Parents of Bunnies may purchase a meal on Zone 4 when registering.

A Bunny Parade will happen immediately prior to the mass start. The purpose of the Bunny Parade is to celebrate the participation of Bunnies and Rabbits this season. The parade also ensures they are grouped together and safely seeded at the back of the mass start.
